Sunday School: 10 – 11am

Youth Sunday School meets during the church Sunday School hour on Sunday mornings in the Youth Center. We start by spending some time together and opening in prayer, we then split into separate groups, middle school and high school and spend some quality time hanging out and in group Bible Study.

Summer Wednesday Night Youth: 6pm - ? (Combined MS & HS)

Our Wednesday night youth during the summer season is more laid back than during the school year and is combined with both our middle school and high school students here for the whole time. We stay later than 8pm, typically wrapping things up around 8:30-45ish. We have less structure and focus more on shenanigans and pool parties, but still meet for worship, prayer or a short lesson. After youth officially ends we have a group that sticks around and has dinner in the youth space and hangs out till I finally make them leave, time dependent on what we've got going the next day. Dinner rotates between a handful of local catering options, so if you want to join us for dinner you need to pitch in \$6 and get it to me by 6:15p so I can get your food ordered. If you would like to join us, we can typically be found in the Youth Center, on the deck, or playing games in the fields behind the church.
