Show Me Your Face

Romans 12:1-5, 10, 18

If real conversations are a spiritual practice—places where God may be present—then how we enter them matters, because not every conversation becomes a means of grace.

1. Come open, not armed
2. Begin with humility and assume good faith
3. Aim for understanding, not agreement
4. Do not force resolution
5. Stay in it when it gets difficult

Pray before you speak, as you listen, and after you leave, inviting God into the conversation, trusting that grace can work in the words, the silence, and what remains unfinished.


